

Coronavirus Statement



As the World Health Organisation (WHO) have recently declared the Coronavirus a Global Health Emergency, there is an air of uncertainty as to how this will affect the UK and at what severity.

As a supplier of antibacterial and health safeguarding products we wanted to outline our contingency plan regarding these products, so you can be assured of their availability should they be required.

/ Consistent Monitoring

We are consistently monitoring the ongoing developments of the Coronavirus outbreak via regular alerts from the WHO update service and various other media news coverage outlets, so that we can keep abreast of any changes and act accordingly.

/ Stock Levels

We have already experienced an increase in demand for certain health safeguarding products, and as such have already acted accordingly to ensure the correct stock levels are in place as we anticipate a continued demand over the coming months. Utilising our strong relationships with our suppliers we have already purchased and ringfenced large quantities of stock to ensure we have the required availability should these products be required.

As a further measure, we have also dedicated space in our own warehouse for these products to ensure stock levels are kept up as the demand inevitably increases.

/ Priority

Whilst we are confident that we have secured, and will continue to secure, enough stock to cover the increasing demand of these products, in the unlikely event that the situation becomes so severe that stock starts diminishing we will put a 'Priority Customer List' in place.

The priority list will include:

- Education sector and any establishment that deal with children (Nurseries etc..)
- Organisations that care for the elderly
- Public Sector Organisations that deal with vulnerable people
